All results are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Thursday, August 13, 2020.

## Methodology

Interviews were conducted August 9-12, 2020 among a random national sample of 1,000 registered voters (RV). Landline (214) and cellphone (786) telephone numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.
The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).

Fox News Polls before 2011 were conducted by Opinion Dynamics Corporation.
