## MICHIGAN

Methodology
Interviews were conducted October 17-20, 2020 among a random sample of 1,104 Michigan voters contacted on landlines (295) and cellphones (809).

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.
A subsample of 1,032 has been defined as likely voters (LV), with a margin of error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.

Telephone numbers were randomly selected from a statewide voter file of registered Michigan voters using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers are proportionally representative to the number of voters in all regions across the state.

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).

Fieldwork conducted by Braun Research, Inc. of Princeton, NJ.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
An asterisk (*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent.
A dash (-) represents a value of zero.
Some percentages may not add to $100 \%$ due to rounding. In the same way, percentages in "total" columns may be one point more or less than the sum of their parts due to rounding.

## Fox News Poll -- Margin of Error for Subgroups

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw \& Company Research (R). Interviews were conducted by telephone (landline and cellphone) with live interviewers October 17-20, 2020 among a random sample of 1,104 Michigan registered voters and 1,032 likely voters. Results based on the full sample and likely voter sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus three percentage points.
