Questions 1-5, 7-8, 12-15, 17, 25, 31-32 \& 45 are for release after 6PM/ET Fri., Dec. 11, 2020. Questions 6, 9-11, 16, 18, 22-24, 26-30, 33-44 \& 46 are for release after 6PM/ET Mon., Dec. 14, 2020. Questions 19-21 are held for future release.

## Methodology

Interviews were conducted December 6-9, 2020 among a random national sample of 1,007 registered voters (RV). Landline (239) and cellphone (768) telephone numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.
The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).
