After further review of the facts in this case, the following circumstances exist: Colon Colon solicited an associate/suspect on 4/16/21, to "send a message" to the victim. Colon Colon drove with the associate/suspect to the [redacted] parking garage. Colon Colon told the associate/suspect where the victim parked her vehicle and discussed details on how to hurt the victim, such as cutting her face. Colon Colon paid the associate/suspect \$100 to hurt the victim. Based upon this information, Colon Colon acted as a principal to this crime by aiding, abetting, counseling, hiring, and otherwise procuring his associate to commit a felony. On 4/17/21, an unknown suspect battered the victim with a deadly weapon, resulting in severe cuts and slices to her face. The attack happened while she was still inside her vehicle, after parking inside of the parking garage [redacted]. The unknown suspect was inside the driver's doorway and partially inside the vehicle. This crime happened at the direction of Colon Colon.

Probable cause is established to charge Colon Colon with Burglary of a Conveyance with an Assault and Battery with a Weapon (FSS 810.02(1)(B)(1)-18). [redacted].

NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 17 of April 2021 at 21:50 at 189 S ORANGE AVENUE (Zone: d) in Orange County did

On 4/17/21, I, Detective Smith (16215) assisted patrol officers with a stabbing investigation, occurring at 2152 hours, at 189 S Orange Avenue (Plaza garage). Patrol officers received an emergency call for service indicating the victim was stabbed in the parking garage as she exited her vehicle. The victim ran [redacted] and waited for police. According to Officer Juarbe (31872), she arrived at [redacted] and obtained the following information:

The victim stated she parked her vehicle in [redacted] the parking garage [redacted]. Once the victim parked her vehicle, she opened her driver's side door and reached over to grab her bag which contained her belongings. She stated as she was grabbing her bag, an unknown younger Hispanic male approached her. The unknown male struck the victim and she began kicking him to fight him off. The victim recalls the unknown male striking her in a punching motion. The victim stated that the male fled in a gray or light-colored vehicle. She stated unknown male did not say anything to her prior to this attack nor did she recognize him. Officer Juarbe observed two lacerations to her face, one to the left side of her nose and another laceration from the left side of her cheek to the left ear. Present in the hospital with the victim was Alexis Jose Colon Colon. He provided contact information, including his phone number of 407-413-0153. [redacted]. Officer Juarbe obtained an initial alibi from Colon indicating he was home during the incident. [redacted]

Upon walking the crime scene, I observed the victim's vehicle parked [redacted]. There was a significant amount of blood around the driver's portion of the vehicle. I also observed a trail of blood leading to the elevator, which was consistent with the victim running to her place of work. I obtained video footage from the garage of the 3rd floor elevator area. The footage from this area shows the victim's vehicle enter the [redacted] parking area 2151:37 hours, then travel out of the camera view. It then shows a light colored four door vehicle directly behind her (2151:41 hours). This vehicle is then seen several seconds later traveling back into the camera view in the opposite direction, presumably toward the exit. Based upon this information, I back-tracked the garage cameras and determined the victim entered the garage at approximately 2149 hours. I then observed the light colored four door vehicle, identified now as a Toyota Prius, follow the victim up the garage to the [redacted] parking area. It should be noted that it was reasonable, based upon the traffic inside the garage at the time, that it took approximately two minutes to travel several floors in the garage.

I then fast-forwarded the video and observed the same vehicle, light colored Toyota Prius, exit the garage at approximately 2155 hours. The vehicle is seen without a tag attached. It should be noted that I obtained a transaction report from the garage indicating the driver of this vehicle obtained a parking ticket at 2149 hours from the lane two kiosk. The report further indicates the ticket was returned to the lane five kiosk at 2155 hours. This information was consistent with the timestamp on the video from the garage. Based upon this information, I believe this light colored Toyota Prius to be the suspect vehicle. I also obtained the parking ticket (ticket # 99772) for forensic processing. I also determined that the suspect did not have to pay for parking because he was inside the garage for less than 15 minutes.

After further review of the street cameras in the area, I located the victim's vehicle traveling east through the intersection of S Orange Blossom Trail and W Washington Street at 2129 hours, followed by the suspect vehicle. At 2131 hours, the victim's vehicle, followed by the suspect vehicle, continue east through the intersection of W Washington Street an N Westmoreland Drive. Several other cameras observe the victim's vehicle, followed by the suspect vehicle, as it travels into the area of the parking garage. These times are consistent with the video from the parking garage, showing the victim enter at approximately 2148 hours.

Street cameras further show the suspect vehicle travel east on E Church Street and S Rosalind Avenue at approximately 2157 hours, after exiting the garage. At 2158 hours, the suspect vehicle is seen traveling westbound on W South Street and S Rosalind Avenue. The vehicle is

seen continuing westbound through the downtown corridor, however it eventually travels out of camera view.

On 4/20/21, I conducted a follow up interview with the victim at her residence. During the interview, I discovered there is a documented history of violence between the victim and Colon Colon [REDACTED]. In this incident, the victim alleged that Colon Colon battered her. As a result, officers determined probable cause was established to charge Colon Colon with battery. She informed me of other undocumented incidents of violence. The victim stated approximately two weeks prior to the attack in the garage, she discovered a tracking device on her vehicle. She explained she confronted Colon Colon about the device, and obtained a partial admission from him. She stated she originally suspected that he placed the device on her vehicle because of jealousy issues. The victim stated she did confront Colon Colon about this incident, but believes his denials. I collected the tracking device from the victim for forensic processing.

After questioning the victim regarding the Toyota Prius, she indicated she remembers Colon Colon being associated at one point with a tow yard on Ferguson Drive. The victim was not specific about the vehicle and tow yard, but believed she observed a light colored Prius at this tow yard in the past. On 5/4/21, I traveled to 605 Ferguson Drive (TRL Towing). Upon my arrival, I observed a gold Toyota Prius with a Florida temporary tag (CXW3017) parked in the lot. I obtained pictures of the vehicle before it left the scene. I later obtained surveillance video from the tow yard showing the occupants as they entered and left the scene. The vehicle is identified as a gold 2011 Toyota Prius, registered to UP RENTAL CAR FORT LAUDERDALE LLC. A public records search from Sunbiz.org reveals the company owner is Witness 2 (NOI) with an address in Windermere, Florida.

Upon further review of the picture I obtained from the tow yard, I observed dealership logo on the left bottom portion of the trunk (Cedar Rapids Toyota Scion). I also observed a tow hitch on the rear the vehicle. In the surveillance video from the garage, I can clearly observe a logo or emblem in the same area. I can also observe the trailer hitch in the garage video and street camera from S Orange Blossom Trail and W Washington Street. Based upon this information, I had probable cause to believe this was the suspect vehicle. Street cameras from the area captured the vehicle on 4/27/21 at 1937 hours, in the area of Capri Place, Orlando, Florida. Detectives Maldonado (31299) and Hammond (19645) performed a traffic stop on the vehicle at 3575 Vineland Road. The driver and passenger were identified as Witness 1 and Witness 2, who were both fully identified. During a road side interview, I learned two vehicles were rented during the timeframe of the attempted murder. The vehicles were identified as a silver Jeep Cherokee-NOI and this Toyota Prius. Witness 2 stated that two subjects were present during the rent transaction, however the transaction was cash and there was no receipt. Witness 2 informed me that one of these subjects, identified as Witness 3 (who I have fully identified), was arrested. Witness 2 stated he was eating dinner with his wife-NOI, on 4/21/21, when he received a call from 407-413-0153. The caller informed him of the arrest of Witness 3 and the tow of the silver Jeep, and requested to return the Toyota Prius. Witness 2 stated that two men arrived and returned the vehicle to him. Witness 2 stated he recognized one of the men who returned the Toyota Prius, as being present with Witness 3 during the initial rent transaction, however did not recognize the other. Witness 2 stated he does not personally know this subject, but would be able to recognize him. He described this familiar subject as a Hispanic male with a beard. This phone (407-413-0153) number was identified as belonging to Alexis Jose Colon Colon [REDACTED]. I showed a single D.A.V.I.D. image of Colon Colon to Witness 2, which he immediately identified as the other individual present during the rent transaction.

On 5/6/21, I met with Witness 3. Witness 3 provided a sworn recorded statement in reference to his involvement with the Toyota Prius. He confirmed he rented the vehicle and was present with an individual he knew only as "Joker". Witness 3 explained that he purchased drugs from "Joker" at his house on multiple occasions and could fully identify him. Witness 3 also described the house that "Joker" lived at, which was consistent with the known description and location of the victim's house. Based upon this information, I believed "Joker" to be Colon

Colon. I showed Witness 3 a single image of Colon Colon, which he confirmed was "Joker". I also showed a Google Street image of the victim's residence, which Witness 3 confirmed he had visited multiple times.

Witness 3 stated that "Joker" wanted to "hurt" a female that upset him. "Joker" described the girl as someone who [REDACTED], and asked if Witness 3 knew anyone that could help him out. As Witness 3 replied, "no", they picked up an associate of "Joker" to drive around with them. Witness 3 explained that he does not know the identity of "Joker's" associate, but identified him as a homeless spanish male. As they drove around, Witness 3 overheard a conversation where "Joker" explained to his associate that he wanted a female "hurt". "Joker" continued to explain this female works in the Downtown Orlando area. Witness 3 stated he drove "Joker" and the associate around the downtown area [REDACTED]. "Joker" explained that she [REDACTED]. Witness 3 stated they drove into the parking garage and located the area where the female would park. Witness 3 also explained he over heard, and observed "Joker" pay \$100 to the associate for "hurting" the female. Witness 3 confirmed these events took place on 4/15/21 at approximately 1800 hours. Witness 3 stated he left "Joker" and the known associate with the vehicle that evening. Witness 3 stated he met with "Joker" again on the 5/19/21, which lead to the arrest.

Witness 3 also described "Joker" [REDACTED]. He knew her to drive a [REDACTED] as well. During the interview, it was apparent to me that Colon Colon AKA "Joker" provided information to Witness 3 revealing that he was soliciting someone to attack a female victim. This female victim was later identified to be [REDACTED]. At this time, Colon Colon's associate is not identified.

On 5/6/21, myself and Detective Marra (16886) conducted a sworn recorded interview with Colon Colon. Post Miranda, he denied all involvement in this case. [REDACTED].

As Colon Colon solicited an associate, by requesting, and hiring said associate, to commit the offense of Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon (DV), probable cause exists to charge him with PUBLIC ORDER CRIMES-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT FELONY SECOND DEGREE (FSS 777.04(1)-6).
