## Methodology

Interviews were conducted September 26-29, 2021 among a random sample of 901 Virginia registered voters contacted on landlines (205) and cellphones (696).

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.
Telephone numbers were randomly selected from a statewide voter file of registered Virginia voters using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers are proportionally representative to the number of voters in all regions across the state.

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
