Questions 1-36, 42-49, \& 59-63 are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Thursday, August 11, 2022. Questions 37-41 and 50-58 are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Thursday, August 12, 2022.

## Methodology

Conducted August 6-9, 2022, this Fox News Poll includes interviews among 1,002 registered voters (RV) nationwide who were randomly selected from a national voter file and spoke with live interviewers. Landline (161) and cellphone (841) telephone numbers were selected for inclusion using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.
The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).

Fox News Polls before 2011 were conducted by Opinion Dynamics Corporation.
