Questions 1-12, 18-28, and 52A-52B are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Thurs. June 29, 2023. Questions 13-17 and 29-52 were for release after 6:00 PM/ET Wed. June 28, 2023.

## Methodology

Conducted June 23-26, 2023, this Fox News Poll includes interviews among 1,005 registered voters (RV) nationwide who were randomly selected from a national voter file and spoke with live interviewers. Landline (148) and cellphone (857) telephone numbers were selected for inclusion using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.
The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).

Fox News Polls before 2011 were conducted by Opinion Dynamics Corporation.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted. An asterisk (*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent. $A$ dash (-) represents a value of zero.
Some percentages may not add to $100 \%$ due to rounding. In the same way, percentages in "total" columns may be one point more or less than the sum of their parts due to rounding.
