LARRY PICKENS DID UNLAWFULLY COMMIT THE OFFENSE OF:

FIRST DEGREE MURDER - TCA 39-13-202 & AGGRAVATED ASSAULT - TCA 39-13-102.

ON TUESDAY 07/11/2023 AT 2:03 PM, COLLIERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT RESPONDED TO AN ACTIVE SHOOTER AT THE CAMPBELL CLINIC AT 1458 W. POPLAR AVENUE, SUITE 100 IN COLLIERVILLE, SHELBY COUNTY, TN 38017, WHERE ONE VICTIM WAS SHOT.

VICTIM/WITNESS, NURSE PRACTITIONER [REDACTED] IDENTIFIED LARRY PICKENS AS THE SHOOTER AND WAS FAMILIAR WITH HIM FROM PREVIOUS VISITS TO CAMPBELL CLINIC. VICTIM MCGUINN ADVISED THAT SHE WAS IN EXAM ROOM C-2 WHERE MR. PICKENS WAS A PATIENT AT CAMPBELL CLINIC AND HE WAS BEING TREATED BY DR. BENJAMIN MAUCK WHEN MR. PICKENS REMOVED A PISTOL FROM HIS WAISTBAND AND FIRED THREE (3) ROUNDS AT DR. MAUCK.

UPON POLICE ARRIVAL, DR. MAUCK WAS FOUND DECEASED IN EXAM ROOM C-2 AND DETECTIVES LOCATED ONE GUNSHOT WOUND TO HIS NECK, ONE TO HIS CHEST AND ONE TO HIS UPPER ABDOMEN. ALSO DISCOVERED IN EXAM ROOM C-2 WAS PAPERWORK WITH THE NAME OF SUSPECT LARRY PICKENS. MULTIPLE EMPLOYEES ALSO IDENTIFIED LARRY PICKENS AS THE PERSON WHO SHOT DR. MAUCK.

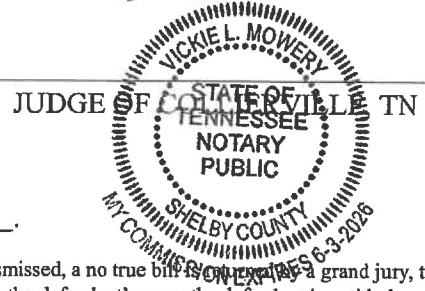
THE SUSPECT FLED THE SCENE AND WAS POINTED OUT TO RESPONDING OFFICERS BY A BAPTIST HOSPITAL SECURITY OFFICER WALKING ON POPLAR AVENUE NEAR THE ENTRANCE TO CAMPBELL CLINIC. MR. PICKENS WAS ORDERED TO THE GROUND AND TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND IDENTIFIED BY HIS TENNESSEE ID# 120 535 111 WHICH WAS LOCATED INSIDE A BACKPACK HE WAS WEARING ALONG WITH A BLACK SMITH & WESSON SD40 PISTOL WITH AN EMPTY CHAMBER AND TWO (2) EMPTY MAGAZINES.

DUE TO THE ABOVE LISTED FACTS, LARRY PICKENS IS FOUND TO BE IN

VIOLATION OF FIRST DEGREE MURDER - TCA 39-13-202 & AGGRAVATED ASSAULT - TCA 39-13-102.
