



# LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER DEATHS 01/01/2023-07/31/2023

This is a graphic presentation of data regarding line-of-duty deaths, both felonious and accidental, collected from law enforcement agencies across the United States and U.S. territories by the FBI's Law Enforcement Officers Killed and Assaulted Data Collection. This preliminary information is provided for officer safety studies, training, and other initiatives. The data are also published annually in the Law Enforcement Officers Killed and Assaulted release. The below data is accurate as of 07/31/2023.

#### **KEY OBSERVATIONS**

The 38 law enforcement officers feloniously killed in the first seven months of 2023 are equal to the 38 officers killed during the same period in 2022. Firearms were used in 32 of the 38 felonious deaths in 2023. The leading circumstances surrounding officers' felonious deaths included activities related to investigative/enforcement (8), crimes in progress (6), pursuits (5), and ambushes (4). Accidental law enforcement deaths decreased 56.41 percent when comparing the first seven months of 2023 (17) with those of 2022 (39). The accidental deaths in 2023 were due primarily to motor vehicle accidents (11), aircraft crashes (2), and pedestrian officers struck by vehicles (2). The southern region has the most law enforcement deaths in 2023 with 24 deaths total (13 felonious, 11 accidental). Although not represented in the below graphic, 13 officers died from the following medical conditions in 2023: 2 officers died from conditions related to 9/11, 2 officers died from cancer, 1 officer died from illnesses related to COVID-19, and 8 officers died due to other natural causes.




