FACTS CONSTITUTING REASONABLE CAUSE

I, Detective Matt Hoffine, of the Little Rock Police Department state the following is true to the best of my knowledge.

On Saturday, August 19th, 2023 at approximately 1732 hours, Officers responded to a Cutting Just Occurred call for service at 1121 West 7th Street. The complaint advised that a MEMS employee, later identified as [REDACTED] was located on the parking lot near her vehicle suffering from an unknown injury. Upon arrival, Officers located [REDACTED] suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. [REDACTED] was transported by MEMS to a local hospital for medical attention. [REDACTED] was listed in extremely critical condition. Major Crimes Detectives and CSSU were notified and responded to the scene.

Detectives began a preliminary investigation and canvassed the area for witnesses and surveillance footage. Detectives made contact with several

MEMS employees advised that Mr. Pena-Romero was also an employee of MEMS, however, he had recently been suspended pending a criminal investigation of Rape against Ms. Pena-Romero in another jurisdiction. Detectives obtained surveillance footage from MEMS that showed several minutes prior to the shooting, a black 2021 GMC Sierra bearing Arkansas LPN 369ZXW is observed entering the secured employee parking lot from an open entry gate. The vehicle is observed driving through the parking lot and parking in the parking spot directly next to Ms. Pena-Romero's 2019 blue Fiat 500X bearing Arkansas LPN MRSPENA. Shortly after the shooting, the black 2021 GMC Sierra is observed fleeing the scene. The black GMC Sierra is the only vehicle observed leaving the area immediately after the shooting at a high rate of speed.

Detectives made contact with several MEMS employees who advised Mr. Pena-Romero had called several co-workers on today's date inquiring where [REDACTED] was and if she was at work on today's date.

Detectives obtained video surveillance from a vehicle dash camera of a MEMS employee and confirmed the license plate of the GMC Sierra as Arkansas license plate number 369ZXW. The vehicle showed to be registered to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in Maumelle, Arkansas.

Detectives made contact with [REDACTED] who advised the vehicle was rented to Mr. Pena-Romero as a part of an "Air B-n-B" rental that Mr. Pena-Romero had made through [REDACTED] [REDACTED] provided a photograph of Mr. Pena-Romero's Arkansas issued driver's license and confirmed Mr. Pena-Romero was the only person who should be in possession of the vehicle. [REDACTED] advised the vehicle was equipped with On-Star. Detectives made contact with On-Star who advised the vehicle was traveling at a high rate on speed westbound on Interstate 30 near Texarkana, Arkansas. Detectives made contact with troopers with the Arkansas State Police and they were provided the vehicle information and approximate location.

At approximately 2025 hours, Arkansas State Troopers located the vehicle near Interstate 30 in Texarkana, Arkansas. Once located, On-Star disabled the vehicle and Mr. Pena-Romero was taken into custody. Mr. Pena-Romero was the driver of the vehicle and the only occupant of the vehicle. Arkansas State Troopers reported observing a handgun in plain view inside of vehicle. Mr. Pena-Romero was transported to Major Crimes and the vehicle was towed to the crime scene bay pending a search warrant.

Detectives located an active no contact order issued by Maumelle Police Department on August 7th, 2023. The order's expiration date shows to be August 7th, 2024. The protected party is Ms. Cassandra Pena- Romero and the order is issued to Mr. Pena-Romero to stay at least five hundred (500) yards away from [REDACTED]. Mr. Pena-Romero was read his Miranda Rights and agreed to provide a recorded statement. Mr. Pena-Romero admitted to shooting his wife and being on the scene. Mr. Pena-Romero was charged with Domestic Battery 1st, Violation of a No Contact Order, and Unauthorized use of another person's property to facilitate certain crimes, and transported to PCRJ without incident.

On August 23rd, 2023 [REDACTED] succumbed to her injuries while at UAMS hospital.

Based on the statements of Mr. Omar Pena-Romero, control of the suspected vehicle, and video evidence of the incident, he was charge with Domestic Battery 1st Degree. Detective Hoffine believes there is evidence to support a charge of Capital Murder against Omar Pena-Romero based upon the death of [REDACTED] due to injuries sustained during the same incident, and asks that a warrant be issued for same.
