

Conducted September 9-12, 2023 under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R), this Fox News national poll includes interviews among 1,012 registered voters who were randomly selected from a national voter file and spoke with live interviewers on both landlines and cellphones. Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus three percentage points. Results among the attached subgroups have larger sampling errors.
