SCOTT R. PETERS declares under penalty of perjury:

That I am a deputy prosecuting attorney for Pierce County and I am familiar with the police report and/or investigation conducted by the TACOMA POLICE DEPARTMENT, incident number 2133201274;

That the police report and/or investigation provided me the following information;

That in Pierce County, Washington, between November 10, 2021, and November 28, 2021, the defendant, HENRY WILLIAM HAUSER, JR, did commit rape first degree and kidnapping first degree sexually motivated.

On 11/28/21, the victim, A.H., waived down a civilian. She reported that she was being held hostage. The civilian observed a chain around her ankle and called police. Police responded and observed the chain on her ankle. Fire personal would have to respond and use tools to remove the chain. The victim reported to police that she met the defendant about two weeks ago. She was homeless and he offered her a place to stay in his garage. She went with him and he later restrained her, bound her in chains and sexually assaulted her. The victim gave a consistent story to medical providers. The victim was able to describe the defendant and his tattoos.

The victim later gave an interview to detectives. She said that after going to the

1 defendant's garage, they hung out for a period of time. At some point she became  
 2 uncomfortable and went to leave. The defendant grabbed her and restrained her by  
 3 binder her to a truck with a chain. She said over the course of a couple weeks the  
 4 defendant would give her drugs and it caused memory issues. She said the defendant  
 5 would make statements to her like he was acting out a fantasy. He would ask her if she  
 6 wanted to be hurt, he would says he was going to kill her slowly, but other times would  
 7 say he wanted to "keep" her. She said that on 4 or 5 occasions the defendant  
 8 performed oral sex and/or digitally penetrated her vagina against her will. The  
 9 defendant would tell her how "good" he was and that she would enjoy it. She explained  
 10 that sometimes she would wake and the defendant would be thrusting his body into her  
 11 buttocks. She could not feel anything and could not tell if her was penetrating her or just  
 12 masturbating against her naked body. The victim described how one day the defendant  
 13 left the key for the lock on her chains and she was able to get it and hid it. She later  
 14 used the key to free herself and make her escape. Photos later showed what appeared  
 15 to be bruising on both her ankles.

16 Police located the house the victim was kept at. They obtained a warrant for the  
 17 garage. In searching the garage, they found a truck as the victim described. They  
 18 found bedding material in the bed of the truck. The found chains in the garage. They  
 19 found a bucket that contained a large quantity of urine. The victim had told police she  
 20 was given a bucket to urinate in. Police also found mail in the defendant's name.

21 Police were looking for the defendant and on 12/2 were notified that he was at  
 22 Walmart. When he was contacted, he gave a false name. Police learned his real  
 23 name, detain him and he admitted to giving a fake name. Later he would be interviewed  
 24 by a detective. The defendant initially denied any knowledge or involvement in this  
 25 case. Over the course of the interview, the defendant admitted that this was not true.  
 26 He admitted being in the garage with someone name A[.] (same first name as the  
 victim) for 2-3 days. He denied leaving her in the garage and denied that he bound her  
 or held her against her will. He denied any sex act occurred. The defendant claimed  
 the victim asked to be chained up and he refused.

The investigation is ongoing and additional charges maybe filed. The defendant  
 also has a warrant out for failure to register as a sex offender. The State will also being  
 filing a 3rd strike notification on this case based on the defendant's history.

 OF WASHINGTON THAT THE FOREGOING IS TRUE AND CORRECT.
