STATEMENT OF FACTS

I, Detective Sergeant Frank Hagg, a duly authorized peace officer employed by the Santa Clara Police Department (SCPD), offer the following Statement of Facts based on my investigation which includes visiting the crime scene, interviewing witnesses and associated parties, reviewing official reports, and reviewing evidence.

On 1/16/24 at approximately 2055 hours, SCPD officers responded to a welfare check a Valley Way in Santa Clara. When officers arrived, they contacted the reporting party (R/P), who stated that his friend, Suspect Liren Chen (DOB: 5/10/96, PFN: EHK487), lived at the residence with his wife, No one else lived there or was currently staying there. The R/P had eaten dinner with Chen and the previous evening at their home and he was concerned about a noticeable change in Chen's demeanor. Chen was quiet and staring blankly for much of the evening. On the morning of 1/16/24, the R/P and his wife tried to call Chen and but could not get through to them.

When the R/P arrived at Chen's home, no one would answer the door. He went to the rear of the home and saw Chen through a window, but he could not get Chen to respond to him. Chen was motionless on his knees, had his hands in the air, and was staring blankly. The R/P called 911 and officers soon tried to hail Chen from the residence. They observed Chen through the window with what appeared to be blood on his jacket and socks.

The officers made entry into the residence and took the Suspect into custody. In the bedroom directly behind where Chen had been standing, officers located deceased on the floor. She had severe blunt force injuries to her head and there was significant blood spatter on the floor, wall, and the back of the bedroom door where she was found. Ofc. Wright pronounced her as deceased.

SCFD personnel responded and asked Chen how he hurt his hand. Chen replied, "I punched my wife." They asked him when this happened and he replied, "Yesterday."

Based on my training and experience and the facts articulated above, I believe Suspect Chen murdered his wife, Victim by striking her in the head repeatedly.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the above synopsis of the investigation is, to the best of my knowledge, true and correct.

The undersigned is informed and believes that:

COUNT 1

On or about January 16, 2024, in the County of Santa Clara, State of California, the crime of MURDER, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a), a Felony, was committed by LIREN CHEN who did unlawfully and with malice aforethought, kill a human being.

It is further alleged against LIREN CHEN, pursuant to California Rules of Court 4.421(a)(1) and Penal Code section 1170(b), that the crime involved great violence, threat of great bodily harm, or other acts disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness, or callousness.

It is further alleged against LIREN CHEN, pursuant to California Rules of Court 4.421(a)(3) and Penal Code section 1170(b), that the victim was particularly vulnerable.

It is further alleged, pursuant to California Rules of Court 4.421(a)(11) and Penal Code section 1170(b), that the defendant, LIREN CHEN, took advantage of a position of trust or confidence to commit the offense.

Any defendant, including a juvenile, who is convicted of and pleads guilty and no contest to any felony offense, including any attempt to commit the offense, charged in this complaint or information is required to provide buccal swab samples, right thumbprints and a full palm print impression of each hand, and any blood specimens or other biological samples required pursuant to the DNA and Forensic Identification Database and Data Bank Act of 1998 and Penal Code section 296, et seq.

Further, attached and incorporated by reference are official reports and documents of a law enforcement agency which the complainant believes establish probable cause for the pretrial restraint of defendant LIREN CHEN, for the above-listed crimes.

Complainant therefore requests that the defendant(s) be dealt with according to law.
