15	"(d) DISPLAY STANDARDS.—The Secretary, in con
16	sultation with the Director, shall ensure that the heads
17	of Federal agencies that post information under sub
18	section (b) comply with display standards established by
19	the Secretary.
20	"(e) Agency Reporting Determination.—No
21	later than 1 year after the date of enactment of the Stop
22	Secret Spending Act of 2024, and not less frequently than
23	once every 2 years thereafter, the Secretary, in coordina
24	tion with the Director, shall—

1	"(1) assess and make a determination with re-
2	spect to which Federal agencies and components of
3	Federal agencies are required to post information
4	under subsection (b);
5	"(2) publish a list of the Federal agencies and
6	components of Federal agencies determined under
7	paragraph (1) on the website established under sec-
8	tion $2(b)(1)$; and
9	"(3) provide to the head and inspector general
10	of each Federal agency or component of a Federal
11	agency included on the list published under para-
12	graph (2) written notice of the inclusion of the Fed-
13	eral agency or component of a Federal agency on the
