During my course of employment, I have investigated criminal incidents of all natures, to include homicides, assaults, burglaries, thefts, drug investigations, etc. I am currently charged with investigating Criminal Offenses that have occurred within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and believe that probable cause, outlined below, exists for issuance of a Search Warrant.

On 02/26/24 at approximately 1226 hours, PA State Police Corry received a phone call transferred through the Crawford County 911 center. The caller process are related that she and Andy BYLER had just returned to Andy BYLER's residence located at Sparta Township, Crawford County. Once they started to enter the residence, they located Andy BYLER's wife, Rebecca BYLER, unresponsive a short distance inside. It appeared that Rebecca BYLER's throat had been cut. PA State Police units were then dispatched to the residence. Upon Troopers arrival, they observed Rebecca BYLER laying on her back in a pool of blood in the living room of the residence. An evident laceration was observed on the front side of Rebecca BYLER's neck in addition to a scalping type wound on her head. Troopers proceeded to clear and secure the scene.
