4 This Act may be cited as the "Guarding American
5 Zones Against Palestinian Immigration Act" or the
6 "GAZA Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. NO IMMIGRATION FROM GAZA.

Beginning on the date of enactment of this Act and
ending on the date that is 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act, an alien who holds a passport issued
by the Palestinian Authority may not—
