2	"(a) Prohibition.—It shall be unlawful for any per-
3	son, in a circumstance described in subsection (b), to will-
4	fully injure or destroy, or attempt to injure or destroy,
5	a structure, plaque, statue, or other monument on public
6	property.
7	"(b) CIRCUMSTANCES.—A circumstance described in
8	this subsection is that—
9	"(1) in committing the offense described in sub-
10	section (a), the defendant travels or causes another
11	to travel in interstate or foreign commerce, or uses
12	the mail or an instrumentality of interstate or for-
