On Tuesday, August 27, 2024, Deputies with the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, responded to the Cost-Less Cleaners located at 4180 South Jog Road- Unit #9, Greenacres, Florida, regarding a stabbing. Upon arrival, deputies located victim #1 (V1), who had sustained a stab wound to their left hand and left torso. Victim #2 (V2), an employee of the aforesaid business advised, the suspect had attempted to rob the business (Cost-Less Cleaners) and fled when V1 intervened. As the suspect fled the business, he stole a marked PBSO patrol vehicle, fleeing north bound. V1 was identified as an off-duty PBSO deputy who arrived at the location to collect their laundry. V1 was transported to the hospital where he/she is in critical but stable condition.

Detectives with the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Violent Crimes Division assumed the investigation and responded to the scene. Detective's interviewed V2, where the following information was learned: he/she was working the cash register of Cost-Less Cleaners when the suspect described as a black male, medium build wearing a gray shirt, possibly a navy/blue hoodie, pants, appearing to be around 60 years of age, entered the business through the front door. The suspected and approached V2 at the cash register, where the suspected demanded V2 to "open the box." V2 observed the suspect holding an unknown object in his left and repeated "open the box" and pointed to the cash register. Fearing for their life, V2 began speaking Spanish to other workers that were present, when she observed V1 (off-duty Deputy) arrive in their marked PBSO patrol vehicle in front of the business. As V1 entered the business the suspect stood off to the side, where V2, attempted to alert V1 of the robbery. Based on V2's motion, V1 tried to greet the suspect, where the suspect brandished a knife, stabbing V1 unprovoked. V1 attempted to create distance exiting the business as the suspect chased after V1. The suspect was then seen entering V1's marked PBSO patrol vehicle, fleeing the area.

As the investigation continued, detectives learned that V1's marked PBSO patrol vehicle had been located at 3656 South Jog Road, Greenacres, Florida, parked along the west side of a church. The recovery of the stolen patrol vehicle was within minutes of the attempted robbery and less than a half mile away. Witnesses in the area stated the suspect fled the area on foot.

As detectives continued the investigation, surveillance cameras from business's located within the same shopping plaza captured portions of the incident. A review of this footage was completed, which confirmed V2 statement. The footage further depicted the suspect as being a black male, wearing a gray t-shirt with a

square design on the front, blue jean pants, black shoes with white trim, and a green hat, possibly with a Philadelphia Eagles emblem. The suspect is observed holding the knife while chasing V1 northbound through the plaza. The suspect returns to the marked patrol vehicle, where the suspect appears to clean the knife with a dark colored rag. The suspect then enters the PBSO marked patrol vehicle fleeing the area in a north bound direction.

Information was obtained through witness #1 (W1) that the suspect was possibly inside the Palm Beach County Library located at 3750 Jog Road, Greenacres. During the search of the area, W1 advised detectives that he/she did not witness the initial incident, but was shown photographs of the surveillance footage recovered by detectives and positively identified the suspect as "Glenn" who goes by the nickname "Jersey." W1 advised detectives that he/she had known "Glenn" for several months as they are homeless and panhandle together in the area of Lake Worth Road and Jog Road. As deputies entered the Library, W1 directed deputies to "Glenn" who was sitting near a computer. Deputies made contact with "Glenn" who was positively identified as Glenn McCoy Gotell (B/M DOB 07/23/1951).

While detectives were checking the immediate area of the library, a gray t-shirt with blood-like-substance was located inside of a trashcan near the entrance of the library, next to two shopping carts with various personal items. W1 identified the pair of clothing to belonging to Gotell and advised he/she had seen Gotell wearing the clothing earlier in the day. Additionally, W1 advised detectives that two shopping carts also located near the entrance of the library belonged to him/her and Gotell. W1 further advised that a pair of blue jean pants with a belt had been hidden between a pair of cushions which W1 identified as belonging to Gotell. Detectives also observed a black pair of Nike shoes with white trim, which were also identified by W1 as belonging to Gotell. These articles of clothing are the exact items Gotell was observed wearing at the time of the stabbing and attempted robbery. W1 further advised detectives that prior to law enforcement making contact with Gotell, he observed Gotell inside the library with a pair of hair clippers in his hand. W1 also advised that several of the local homeless population often take "homeless showers" in the bathroom of the library, specifically in the handicapped stall, where there is more room. W1 saw Gotell in this bathroom stall prior to pointing him out to deputies. He noted seeing a large amount of paper towels on the ground, which he knew Gotell used to bathe himself.

Detectives later conducted a search of the bathroom. There, a pile of balled up paper towles was found on the ground. In addition, there was a used shaving razor found discarded in the trash can. Around the sink were several pieces of cut facial hair, consistent with a male shaving his face.

Detectives conducted a show-up with V2 who advised Gotell strongly resembled the suspect but could not say with a hundred percent certainty.

Based on the aforementioned investigation to include the clothing worn by Gotell at the time of the crime, the still photographs from the surveillance footage which Gotell was immeditately and positively identified by W1 to include specifics of Gotell's clothing. Physical evidence was recovered from within the bathroom of the library which was consistent with Gotell attempting to alter his appearance and avoid apprehension.

Based on the above described investigation, probable cause exist for Glenn McCoy Gotell for yiolation of F.S.S. 782.04(1)(a)(2) Attempted 1st Degree Murder with a deadly weapon, F.S.S. 812.13(1) and (2)(a) Attempted Robbery with a deadly weapon, F.S.S. 810.02(1) and (2)(b) Burglary while armed, and F.S.S. 812.014(1) and (2)(c)(6) Grand Theft of a motor vehicle.
