

Conducted August 23-26, 2024 under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R), this Fox News poll includes interviews among 4,053 Arizona, Georgia, Nevada, and North Carolina registered voters who were randomly selected from a statewide voter file and spoke with live interviewers on landlines and cellphones, or completed the survey online after receiving a text message. Interviews in Arizona and Nevada were conducted by bilingual interviewers. Respondents were given the option of completing the interview in English or Spanish.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 1.5 percentage points. Results among the attached subgroups have larger sampling errors:
