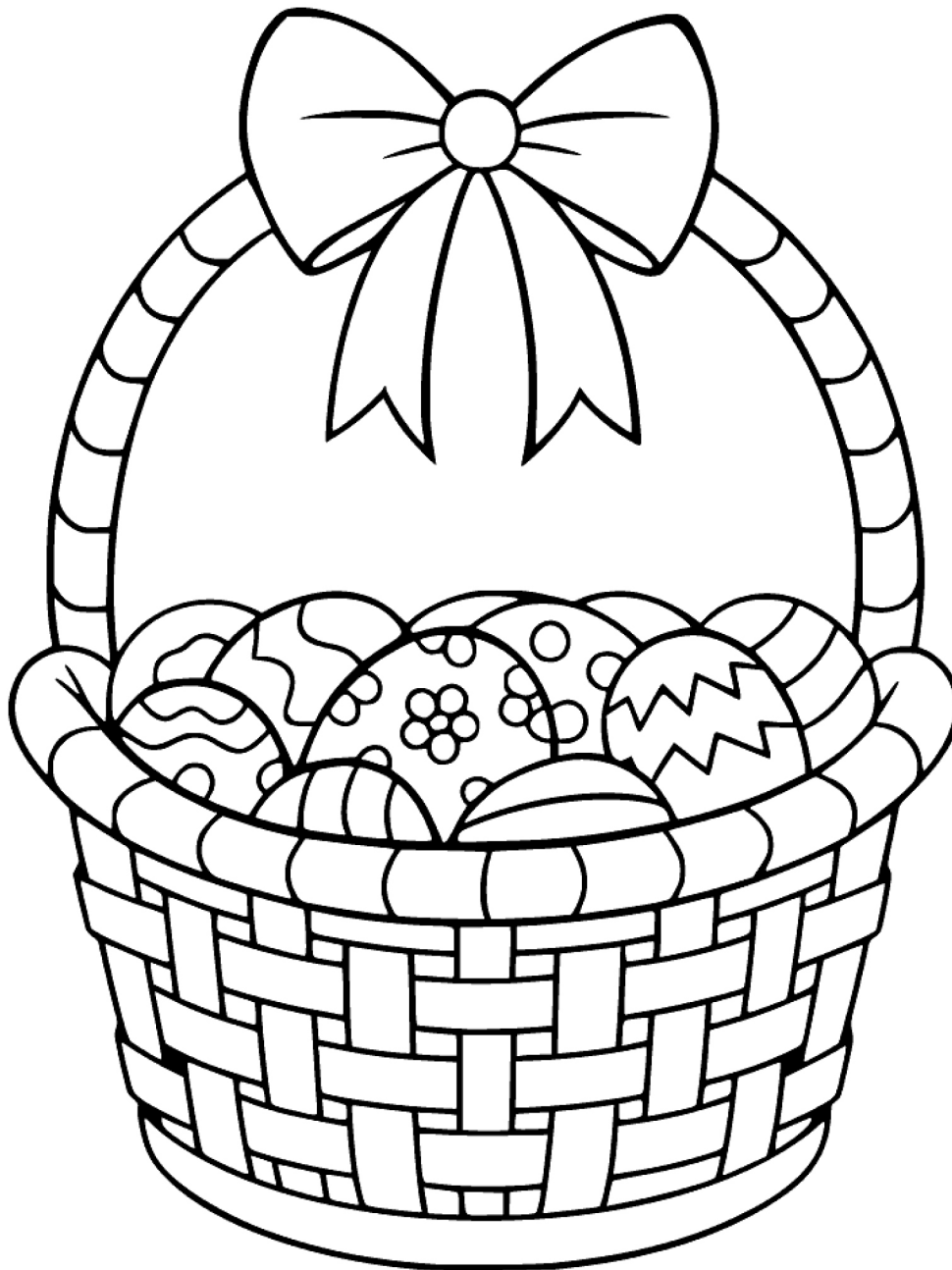

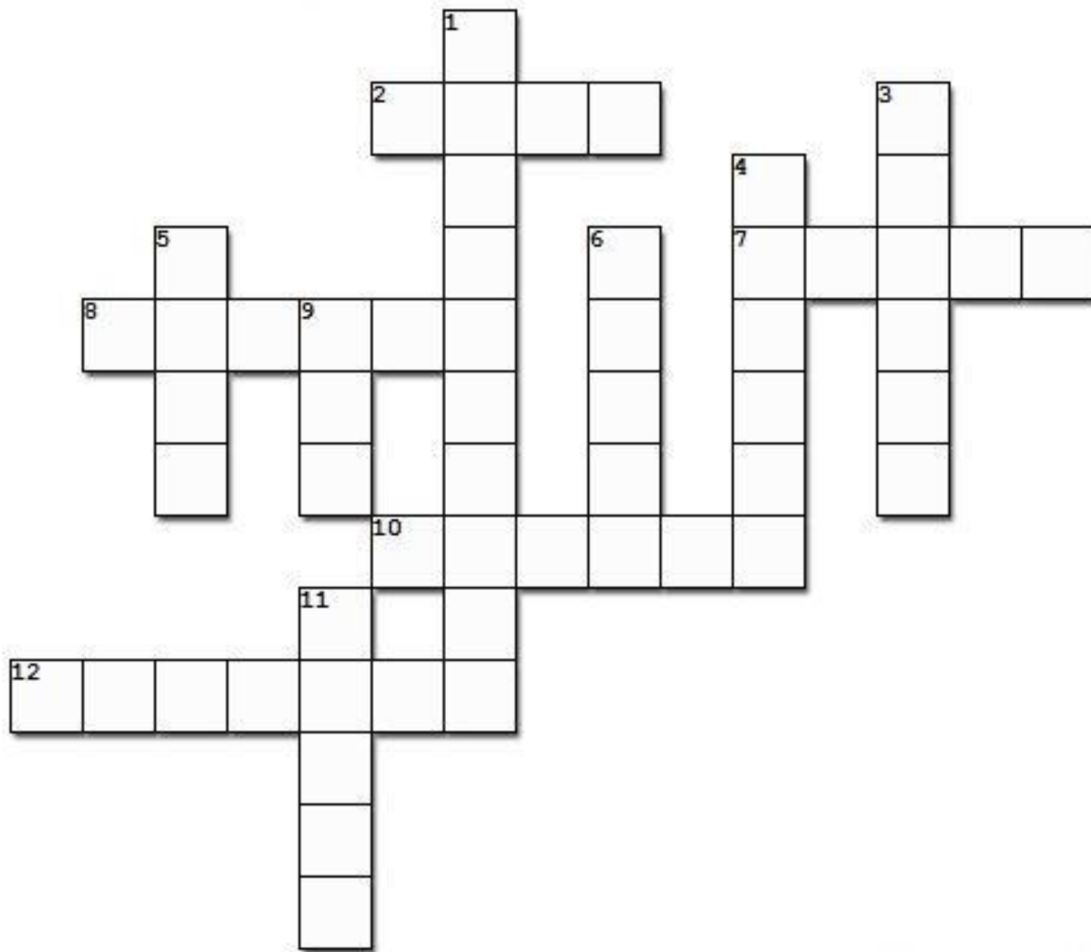

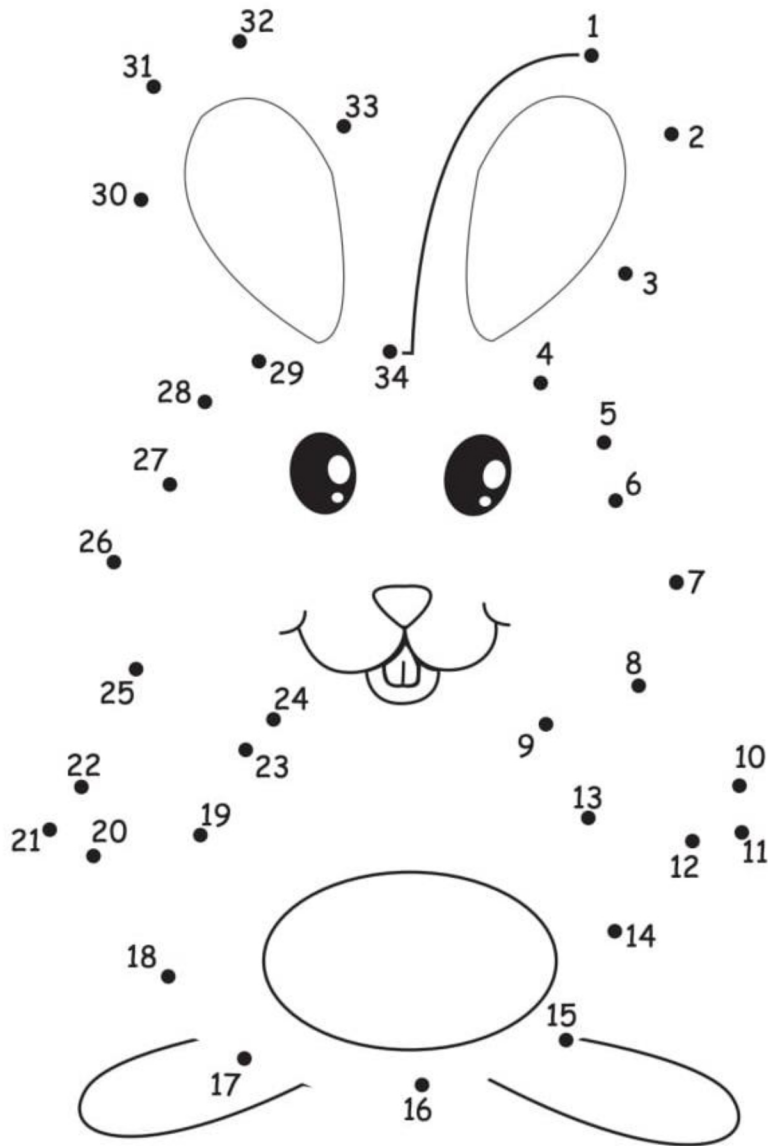

CREATE YOUR OWN EASTER BUNNY

Follow these step-by-step instructions

Items Needed

- Construction Paper
- Pink Marker
- Black Marker
- Scissors

Instructions

- Trace your hand using the black marker/pen on the piece of construction paper. Be sure to leave a little extra space around your fingers.
- Safely cut out the handprint. Tip: make in between the fingers look like a “V”
- Fold down the pinky finger and the thumb towards the middle of the hand so that they touch (these will be the arms)
- Safely cut off the middle finger so that the pointer and ring finger can be the ears
- Using the pink marker, draw the pink parts of the ears and the nose. Using the black marker, add the eyes, whiskers, mouth, and the feet.





EASTER BUNNY CAKE

Follow these step-by-step instructions

- 1 Box of Cake Mix
- 2 Cans of White Frosting
- Food Coloring
- Candy of Choice to Decorate

Instructions

- Follow instructions on the box of cake mix to make two 9-inch round cakes
- Once the two cakes are baked, let them cool completely
- Once cooled, leave one cake whole. Cut the second cake into three pieces: two smaller end pieces and a middle piece.
- Assemble the bunny by using the two smaller end pieces as the ears, and the middle piece as the bowtie.
- Optional – Add any food coloring to the frosting.
- Decorate the cake with the frosting and candy of your choice.



Tip - Use the above example to help cut out the ears and bowtie
