1 fenses poses a significant threat to public safety and 2 Federal property. 3 (2) The desecration or destruction of United 4 States symbols, including flags, in connection with 5 Federal crimes or attempts to intimidate public ac-6 tors amplifies the danger of the underlying crime to 7 the public and to property. (3) The burning of the flag of the United 8 9 States in furtherance of committing a Federal crime 10 reflects an intent to provoke civic unrest, intimidate 11 officials, or signal violent disruption and is an aggra-12 vating factor in the commission of a criminal act. 13 (b) Purpose.—The purpose of this Act is to enhance 14 penalties for the use of incendiary devices, including burning the flag of the United States, in the commission of Federal offenses. 16 SEC. 3. ENHANCED PENALTIES FOR USE OF OPEN FLAMES 18 OR INCENDIARY DEVICES DURING COMMIS-19 SION OF FEDERAL OFFENSES. 20 (a) In General.—Chapter 1 of title 18, United 21 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-22 lowing:

4	"(a) Definition.—For purposes of this section, the
5	term 'incendiary device' includes any flammable object
6	accelerant, fire-starting mechanism, or other apparatus in
7	tended to ignite fire, whether improvised or commercially
8	manufactured.
9	"(b) Enhanced Penalty.—Whoever, in the course
10	of committing a Federal offense involving property dam-
11	age, obstruction of government operations, or public
12	endangerment, knowingly uses or causes the use of ar
13	open flame or incendiary device, including burning the flag
14	of the United States, shall be subject to an enhanced term
15	of imprisonment of not less than 1 year, in addition to
16	any other penalty authorized by law.
17	"(c) Rule of Construction.—This section shall
18	not apply to conduct protected under the First Amend-
19	ment to the Constitution of the United States, including
20	expressive symbolic conduct not involving criminal acts or
21	threats to public safety.".
