

Conducted September 25-28, 2025 under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R), this Fox News poll includes interviews among 1,002 New Jersey registered voters who were randomly selected from a statewide voter file and spoke with live interviewers on landlines and cellphones, or completed the survey online after receiving a text message.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 3 percentage points. Results among the attached subgroups have larger sampling errors. Results among subgroups are only shown when the sample size is at least N=100.
