Dear Chairman Grassley:

This letter responds to your October 11th letter to John Stankey regarding subpoenas sent by Special Counsel Jack Smith seeking phone records of members of Congress. We have received similar inquiries, both formal and informal, from the offices of other members and trust the following information is helpful.

Based on a review of our records:

- AT&T did not receive subpoenas from Special Counsel Jack Smith for phone records of the nine members of Congress named in your letter.
- In May 2023, Special Counsel Smith sent AT&T a grand jury subpoena that included a request for phone records associated with AT&T accounts for two other members of Congress. However, when AT&T raised questions with the Special Counsel Smith's office concerning the legal basis for seeking records of members of Congress, the Special Counsel did not pursue the subpoena further, and no records were produced. For your convenience, attached is a copy of that subpoena and associated nondisclosure order, which expired in May 2024.

In short, based on our review of our files, AT&T has not produced any records or other information to Special Counsel Jack Smith relating to any of the members of Congress named in your letter or, for that matter, any member of Congress.
