Dear Distinguished Members of the Nobel Peace Committee,

We write to you not as policymakers or politicians, but as grieving parents and families who have endured the most unimaginable loss. We are Angel Parents who have buried our children after they were killed by illegal immigrants who should never have been in this country. We are families who have said goodbye to sons, daughters, and loved ones stolen from us by fentanyl and other deadly drugs trafficked across our border by the cartels. We live each day with the pain of empty chairs at our tables and the knowledge that our tragedies could have been prevented.

It is with hearts full of grief, but also with gratitude and urgency, that we ask you to recognize the work of President Donald J. Trump by awarding him the Nobel Peace Prize.

From the day he took office, President Trump identified the cartels and traffickers for what they are: a war machine that destroys lives and destabilizes communities. He made securing our borders a national priority, stemming the flow of illegal drugs and criminals, and saving countless American families from enduring the heartbreak that we have lived. By waging an uncompromising fight against fentanyl networks, violent gangs, and human smugglers, President Trump brought peace and security to neighborhoods across our nation.

While many leaders have spoken about peace in distant lands, President Trump has fought to bring peace right here at home – peace for parents who want their children to walk safely to school, peace for families who should never have to fear a poisoned pill or an impaired driver, peace for communities terrorized by cartels operating freely on our soil.
