

Conducted Nov 14-17, 2025 under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R), this Fox News national poll includes interviews among 1,005 registered voters who were randomly selected from a national voter file and spoke with live interviewers on landlines and cellphones, or completed the survey online after receiving an invitation by text message.
