



Fellow Republican Leaders,

This letter is to advise that after much reflection, prayer, and conversations with my family, I will be stepping down as Chairman of The Republican Party of Virginia at the end of the year. While my time as Chairman will soon come to an end, my work on behalf of Virginians will not. I will continue serving in the State Senate, where I remain committed to standing firmly against radical Democratic policies and fighting for a brighter future for every corner of the Commonwealth.

The Democrats in the Virginia General Assembly passed legislation on October 31, 2025, to destroy our constitutional process for redistricting. The Democrats are intent on setting a State-Wide Referendum for April 2026, which will include 45 days of early voting. As a State Senator, I will be fully engrossed in our legislative session, which lasts from January-March. These will be crucial months that the Chairman of the RPV will need to vigorously lead the fight against the Democrats' blatant Power Grab.

Accordingly, I will be stepping down so that the RPV can elect a new Chairman who will be able to devote their full time, energy, and attention to defeating this Referendum and then leading us to victory in the 2026 U.S. Senate and Congressional races.
