



The primary purpose of this hearing is to ensure that you know and understand the charge or charges against you. At this hearing, there will be no determination made about your guilt or innocence of the crime charged, but only a determination that you know and understand the charge or charges against you. If you are before the court on a complaint following a warrantless arrest, the judge will determine whether there is probable cause for the charge against you.</p> <p>In addition, the purpose of this hearing is to determine whether bail should be set in your case; or, if it has been already set, if it should remain the same, be raised, be lowered, or whether you should be released upon your personal recognizance (that is, your promise to appear for future court proceedings) or released in the custody of some responsible person. In order to make this determination, it will be necessary for the judge to ask you some questions concerning your ties with the community.</p> <p>You are entitled to be represented by an attorney. You have a right to have your own attorney and will be given time and opportunity to retain an attorney. If you are unable to afford an attorney, one will be appointed for you by the court if you qualify for such representation. It will be necessary for you to complete an indigency questionnaire under oath in order for the court to make this determination.</p> <p>You have a right to talk with your attorney, family, or friends and, if necessary, reasonable means will be provided to enable you to do so. You have the right to remain silent. Anything that you say may be used against you.</p> <p>Because you are charged with a felony, you are entitled to demand a preliminary hearing before a judge to determine whether there is sufficient evidence to establish that you probably committed the offense or offenses with which you are charged. You must make this demand within thirty (30) days of the date of arrest. BOND HEARING ORDER

The Defendant appeared before the Court this day for a Bond Hearing in which the Defendant was given the opportunity to make a statement regarding his/her ability to post the bond currently set in this matter. The Court has considered whether Defendant being at large will pose a real and present danger to others or to the public at large. The Court has also considered the least onerous conditions under which Defendant's release will assure the Defendant's appearance at future proceedings in this matter.

It is hereby ORDERED as follows:

Defendant shall not be released since he/she is charged with a non-bailable capital offense.

The identity of responsible members of the community who will vouch for the Defendant's reliability.

Violence or lack of violence in the alleged commission of the offense.

The nature of the offense charged, the apparent probability of conviction, and the likely sentence, insofar as these factors are relevant to the risk of nonappearance.

The type of weapon used, i.e. knife, pistol, shotgun, sawed-off shotgun.

Threats made against the victims and/or witnesses.

The value of property taken during the alleged commission of the offense.

Whether the property allegedly taken was recovered or not; damage or lack of damage to property allegedly taken.

Residence of the Defendant, including consideration of real property ownership, and length of residence in his or her place of domicile.

In cases where the Defendant is charged with a drug offense, evidence of selling or pusher activity should indicate a substantial increase in the amount of bond.





BOND HEARING ORDER

The Defendant appeared before the Court this day for a Bond Hearing in which the Defendant was given the opportunity to make a statement regarding his/her ability to post the bond currently set in this matter. The Court has considered whether Defendant being at large will pose a real and present danger to others or to the public at large. The Court has also considered the least onerous conditions under which Defendant's release will assure the Defendant's appearance at future proceedings in this matter.

It is hereby ORDERED as follows:

Defendant shall not be released since he/she is charged with a non-bailable capital offense.

Defendant shall be released from custody pending further proceedings, subject to the mandatory Conditions prescribed in Rule 7.3(a) of the Alabama Rules of Criminal Procedure, and subject To the following additional conditions:

Own Recognizance

Execution of an unsecured appearance bond in the amount of \$

Execution of a secured appearance bond in the amount of \$ 300,000.00 CASH

Other conditions

If execution of a secured appearance bond is required for release, the secured appearance bond is required due to the consideration of the following factors as applied to Defendant:

- The age, background and family ties, relationships and circumstances of the Defendant.
- The Defendant's reputation, character, and health.
- The Defendant's prior criminal record, including prior releases on recognizance or on secured appearance bonds, and other pending cases.
- The identity of responsible members of the community who will vouch for the Defendant's reliability.
- Violence or lack of violence in the alleged commission of the offense.
- The nature of the offense charged, the apparent probability of conviction, and the likely sentence, insofar as these factors are relevant to the risk of nonappearance.
- The type of weapon used, i.e. knife, pistol, shotgun, sawed-off shotgun.
- Threats made against the victim and/or witnesses.
- The value of property taken during the alleged commission of the offense.
- Whether the property allegedly taken was recovered or not; damage or lack of damage to property allegedly taken.
- Residence of the Defendant, including consideration of real property ownership, and length of residence in his or her place of domicile.
- In cases where the Defendant is charged with a drug offense, evidence of selling or pusher activity should indicate a substantial increase in the amount of bond.
- Consideration of the Defendant's employment status and history, the location of the Defendant's employment, whether employed in the county where the alleged offense occurred, and the Defendant's financial condition.
- Any enhancement statutes related to the charged offense.
- Other: Danger to community - Explodes at will


