



POLITICAL ALIGNMENT OF ABA BRIEF POSITIONS



 ■ Conservative-aligned — 0 briefs



Immigration is the single largest non-mission topic.

13 of 34 progressive briefs concerned immigration, detention, or deportation.

80%

Core mission briefs win at 80%

More than twice any other category. 12W / 15 decided. The ABA performs best on issues directly tied to the legal profession.

Zero briefs supported any Trump administration position.

In cases where Trump or a Trump official was a named party, across both terms.

36%

Progressive social briefs win at just 36%

12W / 33 decided — despite comprising 39% of all briefs filed.

18%

LGBTQ / gender briefs: 18% of all progressive cases.
