IN THE NAME AND BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Before me, the undersigned Assistant District Attorney of Harris County, Texas, this day appeared the undersigned affiant, who under oath says that he has good reason to believe and does believe that in Harris County, Texas, **JENNIFER BESS LOWERY**, hereafter styled the Defendant, heretofore on or about **May 14, 2026**, did then and there unlawfully, while operating a vehicle, and after having been involved in a collision that the Defendant knew was reasonably likely to result in injury to or death of a person, and while knowing that a collision had occurred, intentionally and knowingly fail to immediately stop the Defendant's vehicle at the scene of the collision or as close to the scene of the collision as possible, and the collision resulted in bodily injury to Gabriel Luis Fonseca.

Probable Cause

Affiant, Officer C. Brummarie, is a Peace Officer who is presently employed by the Houston Police Department as a police officer. Affiant has good reason to believe and does believe that on May 14, 2026, at the intersection of 99 Birdsall St. and 5799 Memorial Dr., Houston, Harris County TX, 77007, **JENNIFER BESS LOWERY** (DOB June 25, 1967), hereafter referred to as the Defendant, committed the Felony offense of Failure to Stop and Render Aid (FSRA).

Defendant **JENNIFER BESS LOWERY** was positively identified by her Texas Driver's License Number 06793456.

AFFIANT BELIEFS ARE BASED ON THE FOLLOWING FACTS:

Affiant was dispatched to the intersection of 99 Birdsall St and 5799 Memorial Dr., which is a public roadway located in Houston, Harris County, TX at 2016 hours on May 14, 2026, for a Crash Major call. Affiant arrived to the scene at 2023 hours and observed the vehicle off of the public roadway and parked in an open parking space near the original scene of the crash. Affiant spoke with the driver (Complainant) of a Silver Nissan Altima bearing TX License plate "KMY4585", who identified himself as Gabriel Fonseca with his TX issued Driver's License. Affiant was informed by the Complainant, whom Affiant believes to be credible and reliable, that his vehicle was struck while he was traveling east bound on Memorial Dr. Affiant was informed by the Complainant that he is unsure of where the other vehicle was located when he was struck on the driver's side of his vehicle. The Complainant stated to Affiant that he believes the vehicle was a sedan and it was sitting in the median of Birdsall St. The Complainant stated to Affiant that he was struck and was able to move his vehicle to a safe location, but the other vehicle drove off. Affiant was advised by HFD who was on scene that the Complainant complained about ringing in his ears, which can suggest serious bodily injury. Affiant was informed by the Complainant that it will cost about \$35,000 to have his vehicle replaced or repair and he would like to pursue charges if the driver is located.

While Affiant was collecting information regarding the crash, Affiant was approached by a citizen who identified himself as Trace Marshall, who Affiant believes to be credible and reliable. Witness Marshall informed Affiant that he was walking his dog when he heard a large crash coming from ahead of him. Witness Marshall stated to Affiant that he noticed a severely damaged dark colored sedan driving south on Birdsall St. Witness Marshall informed Affiant that he observed a white, blonde female driving the vehicle about the age of mid 30's to late 40's. Witness Marshall informed Affiant that he continued his walk observing the white female parking the damaged vehicle at 505-A Sandman St. Witness Marshall described to Affiant that the vehicle has substantial front end damage and is leaking fluids. Witness Marshall did inform Affiant that he was not able to get a plate on the vehicle due to the vehicle being parked in reverse and the front end completely missing.

Affiant along with a secondary unit Officers D. Walker and W. Walker, who are presently employed as Police Officers with Houston Police

Department and Affiant believes both Officers to be credible and reliable, traveled to the address provided by Witness Marshall. Affiant along with Officer D. Walker and W. Walker observed the vehicle described by Witness Marshall parked in the driveway of the provided address. Affiant observed the vehicle to be a blue Audi bearing license plate "KCX5173", which is registered to a Jennifer Bess Lowery. Affiant observed the vehicle to be parked outside of a residential garage with the front end of the vehicle towards Sandman St. The vehicle was missing the front bumper and had significant front-end damage.

While taking photos of the vehicle Affiant and secondary unit Officers were approached by a white male, who identified himself as the husband of the driver of the vehicle. Affiant was informed by the male that his wife was involved in a car accident, and he instructed her to park the vehicle at their residence. The male informed Affiant that he is an attorney he will not allow his wife to provide a statement at this time. The male informed Affiant that he is willing to provide all information needed but his wife will not be providing a statement at this time. Affiant requested identification for both the male and his presumed wife along with insurance information for the vehicle.

Affiant identified the male as a Mr. Matthew Willis and his wife, referred to as the Defendant, as JENNIFER BESS LOWERY (TXDL 06793456), both with their Texas Drivers Licenses. Affiant was informed by Mr. Willis that he was not involved in the car accident and that he received a call from his wife regarding the crash. Affiant learned from Officer D. Walker that Mr. Willis informed him of the exact location of the accident. Affiant was informed by Officer D. Walker that Mr. Willis traveled to the scene of the crash and observed where the crash debris.


With the information Affiant contacted Harris County DA Intake Office, via telephone and presented the facts of this case to ADA J. Cullota. ADA Cullota accepted charges for the Felony offense of Failure to Stop and Render Aid (FSRA) for JENNIFER BESS LOWERY. ADA Cullota declined charges for Interfering with Public Duties for Matthew Willis.




