

Conducted July 17-20, 2026 under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R), this Fox News national poll includes interviews among 1,003 registered voters who were randomly selected from a national voter file and spoke with live interviewers on landlines and cellphones, or completed the survey online after receiving an invitation by text message. The survey includes an oversample of 200 voters aged 18-29, bringing the under 30 subgroup sample size to 350.
