

Conducted July 23-27, 2026 under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R), this Fox News poll includes interviews among 1,006 Texas registered voters who were randomly selected from a statewide voter file and spoke with live interviewers on landlines and cellphones, or completed the survey online after receiving a text message. An oversample of 296 registered Hispanic voters randomly selected from a statewide voter file bring the Hispanic subgroup sample size to 556.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 3 percentage points. Results among the attached subgroups have larger sampling errors:
