COMPLAINT

The STATE OF HAWAII, through the undersigned, its
Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, hereby accuses and charges the
Defendant as follows:

COUNT ONE:

That on or about August 1, 2026, in the County of Maui, State of Hawaii, KIRILL BASIN, with the intent to terrorize, or in reckless disregard of the risk of terrorizing another person, did threaten, by word or conduct, to cause bodily injury to another person, by threats made in a common scheme against different persons, including Kama Homan, thereby committing the offense of Terroristic Threatening in the First Degree in violation of Section 707-716(1)(b) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes.

"Bodily injury" means physical pain, illness, or any impairment of physical condition.

The threat being made must be objectively capable of causing fear of bodily injury in a reasonable person and/or persons at whom the threat was directed and who was familiar with the circumstances under which the threat was made and:

- (1) The threat on its face and in the circumstances in which it was made must have been so clear, unconditional, immediate, and specific as to the person and/or persons threatened, that the threat communicated a seriousness of purpose and an imminent likelihood of being carried out; and/or
- (2) KIRILL BASIN possessed the apparent ability to carry out the threat, such that the threat was reasonably likely to cause fear of bodily injury in different persons, including Kama Homan.

When making the threat, KIRILL BASIN must also have consciously disregarded a substantial and unjustifiable risk that the threat was capable of causing fear of bodily injury in a reasonable person and/or persons at whom the threat was directed and who was and/or were familiar with the circumstances under which the threat was made.

The relevant attributes of KIRILL BASIN and the person and/or persons whom the threat was directed, including Kama Homan, must be taken into consideration in determining whether the threat, under the circumstances, was objectively capable of causing fear of bodily injury in a reasonable person.

COUNT TWO:

That on or about August 1, 2026, in the County of Maui, State of Hawaii, KIRILL BASIN, with the intent to terrorize, or in reckless disregard of the risk of terrorizing another person, did threaten, by word or conduct, to cause bodily injury to another person, including Kama Homan, with the use of a dangerous instrument, to wit, a knife, thereby committing the offense of Terroristic Threatening in the First Degree in violation of Section 707-716(1)(e) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes.

"Bodily injury" means physical pain, illness, or any impairment of physical condition.

"Dangerous instrument" means any firearm, whether loaded or not, and whether operable or not, or other weapon, device, instrument, material, or substance, whether animate or inanimate, which in the manner it is used or is intended to be used is known to be capable of producing death or serious bodily injury.

"Serious bodily injury" means bodily injury which creates a substantial risk of death or which causes serious, permanent disfigurement, or protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ.

The threat being made must be objectively capable of causing fear of bodily injury in a reasonable person at whom the threat was directed and who was familiar with the circumstances under which the threat was made and:

- (1) The threat on its face and in the circumstances in which it was made must have been so clear, unconditional, immediate, and specific as to the person and/or persons threatened, that the threat communicated a seriousness of purpose and an imminent likelihood of being carried out; and/or
- (2) KIRILL BASIN possessed the apparent ability to carry out the threat, such that the threat was reasonably likely to cause fear of bodily injury in another person, including Kama Homan.

When making the threat, KIRILL BASIN must also have consciously disregarded a substantial and unjustifiable risk that the threat was capable of causing fear of bodily injury in a reasonable person and/or persons at whom the threat was directed and who was and/or were familiar with the circumstances under which the threat was made.
