I write to express Oklahoma's unwavering opposition to antisemitism and our support for Jewish communities facing persecution around the world.

Reports of increasing violence, intimidation, and discrimination directed at Jewish communities since October 7, 2023, are deeply troubling. It is especially disturbing to see such ugly hostility in western nations that otherwise hold themselves out as bastions of tolerance and civility, such as Canada. No one should be forced to live in fear because of their faith.

Should Jewish families lawfully come to the United States in search of safety and opportunity, I want you to know that Oklahoma would proudly welcome those who choose to make our state their home.

Oklahoma is blessed with a strong and vibrant Jewish community, especially in Tulsa, that has contributed to our state's success since before statehood and stands ready to welcome new neighbors. I know those traditions of faith, family, entrepreneurship, and civic engagement would continue to flourish here.

Thank you for your steadfast leadership in confronting antisemitism and defending religious liberty. Please know that Oklahoma stands ready to support those efforts in any way we can.
